Ernest Maloney Dies in Arkansas

Ernest C. (Pat) Maloney, 58, a former Dallas automobile salesman, died Friday afternoon in the Veterans Hospital at Little Rock, Ark., where he had been a patient for many years.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 p.m. Sunday in Wolfe City.

Maloney attended school in Dallas, then began in the automobile sales business. Shortly after the end of World War I, he entered the Little Rock hospital and remained there since for treatment.

Survivors include two brothers, J. S. Maloney and J. W. Maloney, both of Dallas; a son, J. P. Maloney of Mission, Kan., and four grandchildren.
