MRS. ROSS NO BETTER

CONDITION OF PENNSYLVANIA ACCIDENT VICTIM IS CRITICAL.

Wife of Charles C. Ross Suffers Skull and Leg Fractures in Wreck in Which He Was Killed.

Suffering fractures of the skull and right leg and abrasions on the head and body, Mrs. Margaret Ross, wife of Charles C. Ross, was in a critical condition last night at the Community hospital in Somerset, Pa.

Mrs. Ross was injured and her husband killed about 7:45 o'clock Saturday night fifteen miles west of Somerset after a front tire of their Buick roadster blew out and the car turned over several times into a ditch. Mr. Ross was driving. The couple was returning from New York, where they had gone for a visit after a trip to West Palm Beach, Fla., to see Sergt. James Maloney, 23, son of Mrs. Ross by a former marriage. Maloney left last Tuesday for duty in Puerto Rico.

Neal J. Ross, 3744 the Paseo, a brother, and James Daleo, lawyer and friend of the family, left by plane Saturday night and arrived at Somerset yesterday morning. Ross telephoned that he expected to arrive in Kansas City with his brother's body some time tonight. Daleo will remain at Somerset until Mrs. Ross's relatives arrive there.

Ross was president of the Blue Valley Asphalt company. He was born in Kansas City November 8, 1892, the son of the late Michael Ross, for years a contractor and a partner of T. J. Pendergast in the Ready Mixed Concrete company. He attended Woodland school, De La Salle academy and St. Mary's college.

Besides his wife, he is survived by three children, Mary Margaret Ross, 9; Michael Ross, 10, and Joseph, 6, all of the home near Lee's Summit; four other brothers, Harry R. Ross, 1918 East Thirty-first street; Thomas P. Ross, 107th and High drive; Eugene M. Ross, 3413 the Paseo, and George L. Ross, 3771 Washington street, and four sisters, Mrs. Gordon H. Hamilton, 1055 West Fifty-sixth street; Mrs. Robert T. Stokes, 804 West Sixty-ninth street; Mrs. Francis G. Pendergast, 6525 Valley road, and Mrs. Sherman J. Sexton, Chicago.
