

ROBERT E. GARDNER

DIES AT 69 YEARS

For Almost 22 Years Was Engineer
at Riverside Mine—Was Native
of Illinois.

Robert E. Gardner, 69 years old, a well known resident of this city, died at 6 o'clock this morning at the family home, 301 Linn street. Death followed after a two months' illness.

Mr. Gardner was a native of Illinois, where he was born November 20, 1852. He came to Leavenworth over twenty years ago. Soon after his arrival here he was employed as an engineer at the Riverside Mining Company, a position that he held up until his death. He was a member of Leavenworth lodge No. 2, A. F. & A. M., and was very favorably known here.

Besides his widow, Mrs. Agnes Gardner, he is survived by two sons, John Gardner, of Kansas City, Kan., and George Gardner of Cokedale, Colo., and one granddaughter, Miss Louise Gardner, of the home address.

Funeral arrangements have not yet been completed but will be announced later at the convenience of relatives by the J. C. Davis Undertaking company.
